

Things to remember for Year 4

- ❖ Your child will need to wear their PE kit to school on their PE days. For Year 4 this is a **Monday** and a **Thursday**. Please ensure that your child has the correct PE kit, complete with plain black trainers. If the weather is poor, your child may wear tracksuit bottoms or joggers rather than shorts. They will also need to remember a jumper and coat.
- ❖ Please ensure that all your child's belongings are named in case they are misplaced.
- ❖ School begins at 8:45am each morning. Please make sure your child is on time every day.
- ❖ This year, Year 4 children will be entering and exiting school through the lower gate on Dover Street which will take them through the spiral room.
- ❖ Unfortunately, we will not currently be taking any children swimming due to Covid19. We hope to begin swimming sessions in the near future and will keep you updated.

Homework

Times tables

Towards the end of the year, Year 4 will be taking part in a times tables test set by the government. This test requires your child to be able to answer both multiplication and division questions for every times table quickly; within a six second time limit. Because of this, it is important that your child practices their times tables and becomes fluent in their knowledge. They can use IXL and TT rock stars to help them. Please ask if you are unsure of your child's login.

How can you enrich your child's learning?



There is a lot you can do as a parent to assist your child with their learning:

- ❖ Listen to your child read every night and ask them questions about what they have read. Discuss any new words they come across and sign their reading record.
- ❖ Support them with their homework, but don't do it for them. Ensure they complete all the assigned homework each week.
- ❖ Have a chat with your child each evening. Ask them what they have done at school and how their learning is going.
