## Reading at Bramcote College - How to do Reading Practice (Book Quizzes) from home?

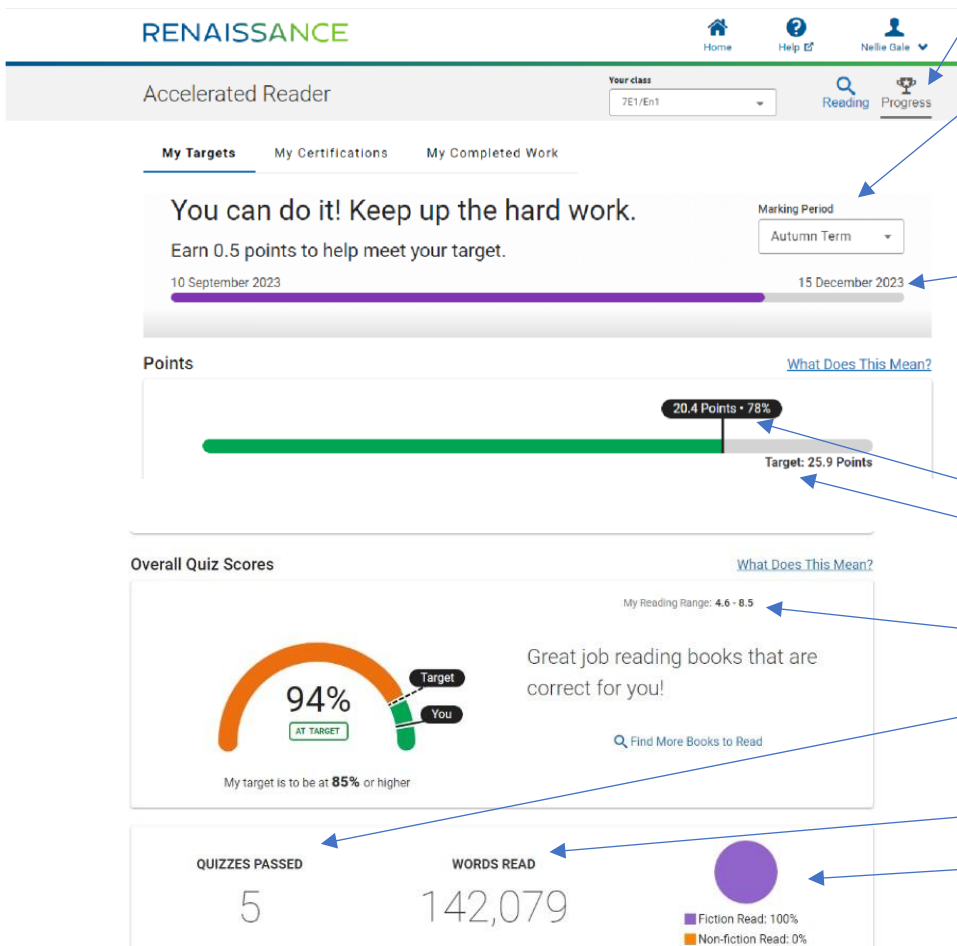
	<p>Your child will take the Star Reading Test four times a year at school. This test will determine their current book level, helping them select appropriate books from the library and boosting their reading success. Each term, your child will have a specific reading target, which you can find on their Reading Expectations Sheet in their Student Planner and Accelerated Reader Account.</p> <p>Your support at home is crucial. Encouraging your child to read for 30 minutes daily as homework will greatly enhance their success in school and life.</p>		
	<p>Our School Library features books that are part of the Accelerated Reader Programme, allowing students to complete a Book Quiz after finishing a book.</p> <p>Your child will select a book from the library that matches their Book Level. Each book has a coloured Accelerated Reader tab on the spine indicating its level. The details for the Accelerated Reader Book Quiz can be found at the front or back of the book</p> <p><b>Book Level</b> <i>(This indicates the level of difficulty. it's broken down from 0.1-0.9 for each level. i.e if Level 3 (BLUE) – 3.1)</i></p> <p><b>Points</b> <i>(The maximum number of points earnt if they get all questions right on the book quiz)</i></p> <p><b>Quiz Number</b> <i>(All books have a 6 digit number so it can be found easily on AR.)</i></p>		
	<p><b>Reading a book from home?</b> You can check if it's on the Accelerated Reader (AR) Programme. This will provide the book level and the number of points that can be earned. Please note that the school librarian will be monitoring what students are reading during library lessons.</p>		<p>Scan the QR Code to access the login page for the AR Reading Practice Book Quiz. Then, proceed to Point 5.</p>



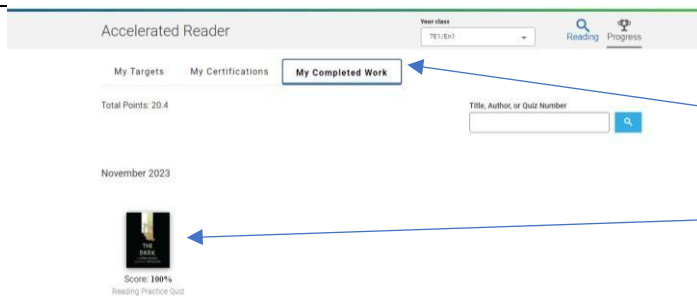
When your child has finished reading a book on Accelerated Reader, they will be able to do a Book Quiz.

	<p>If you can't use the QR Code, visit the school website at <a href="https://bramcote.college/">https://bramcote.college/</a>. (Please note: Access the Accelerated Reader through the school links page only. A Google search for Accelerated Reader will not allow your child to log in.)</p>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select the <b>STUDENT</b> tab.</li> <li>2. Select <b>Resources</b></li> <li>3. <b>Student Links</b> and click on <b>Accelerated Reader</b></li> </ol>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4. A new page will open, Click on <b>I'm a student</b></li> </ol>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>5. Log in – your child should use their username and password.</li> </ol> <p>This is the same username and password used in Computer Science</p>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>6. Click on <b>AR Accelerated Reader</b>.</li> </ol> <p><b>DO NOT CLICK on STAR READING – This section is used for assessing students during their Termly Reading Tests at school. If you accidentally click on it, please close the window and start again.</b></p>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>7. To find a Book Quiz, enter either into the <b>Search Box</b> the Book Title or the easiest and quickest way is by entering the <b>quiz number</b> (this can be found in the front or back of library book) and then click on <b>Search</b>.</li> </ol>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>8. The book will appear on the screen. Click on <b>Take Quiz</b>. Next, select <b>Reading Practice</b> and click <b>Start Quiz</b>.</li> </ol> <p>Please note that for some books, options for Literacy and Vocabulary Practice will also be available. Your child can complete these quizzes too.</p>





13. To see your child's progress, you can click on the cup icon.
14. To see the different terms, click on marking period and a dropdown box will appear to select a term or whole year.
15. This shows the date for when they need to reach their reading target for the term.
16. Points Target
  - Current Score
  - Target Points
 This is reset for each term after their Star Reading Test.
17. Reading Range – Book Level
18. Number of Quizzes Passed and Completed.
19. Words Read
20. Percentage of fiction and non-fiction books read.



21. To see the books your child has read, click on the tab **My Completed Work**. It is broken down into months. Click on the book icon and you will be able to see the breakdown of your child's quiz scores and word count for that book.

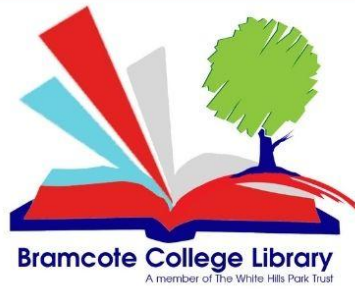


## **HELP PRESERVE OUR BOOKS**
