1. Everybody was welcomed to the School Council meeting and last month's agenda was discussed.

2. Improvements to our School

School Councillors looked at some first suggestions to improve our School.

Paint the PE container outside to make it more appealing to look at

How many children liked this idea?

Everybody liked this idea. Mrs Kirby will discuss this with Mr Brotherton.

A quiet area on the main playground to sit and read – located by year 5's classroom. (This would be a great fundraiser so it could be ready for Summer term).

How many children would like this idea?

All children liked this idea. When we are able to raise funds, this will help contribute towards setting up this area.

Bright-coloured bins on the playground and possibly a bin for Reception playground

Again, everybody liked this idea. We have some money in a grant which could be used to purchase some brightly-coloured bins. Mrs Kirby will speak to Mrs Eggleston to see if it is possible to purchase some for the playground and Reception area.

To add to our collection of free-readers in each classroom around school (Year 6 councillors will speak to Miss Prankard about this).

Everybody was keen to have a wider range of books. Mrs Kirby will see Mrs Prankard about when it is possible to purchase some extra free-readers.

3. <u>Mission Statement</u>

We looked at our Federation mission statement which has not been updated since 2020. Mrs Kirby discussed how we could improve our mission statement and what councillors felt it would be important to include.

Children felt that it was important to include some information about physical as well as mental health. We discussed the work of our new well being lead, Mrs Simpson and the work that she does for us.

Together, we spent time on updating our mission statement to include important messages about physical and mental health. This is our new mission statement with the new sentence highlighted in yellow:
