2. Adventure Playground

Thank you for selecting your favourite products for our adventure playground. FOBS have taken each class' ideas to find the favourite overall choices for Bramham School for play equipment.

The playground company have provided a quote for school for this equipment. It is very costly to buy an adventure playground since it is not just the equipment that has to be bought. It is also important to pay for safety matting for the equipment to stand on and building contractors need to build each piece of equipment carefully.

Mrs Kirby and FOBs will obtain another quote from a different company to compare the costs. By having a smaller number of equipment on our adventure playground, this might also be considered to lower the overall price.

Money can still be raised now for the playground however and FOBS have applied for some funding to help with some of this money. We hope to hear back from them soon to hear if we have been successful.

3. Suggestions to raise money for the Adventure Playground

There were lots of brilliant suggestions for raising money towards the Adventure Playground. Thank you for all your great ideas. Some of your ideas we already have planned for later in the year such as a 'Christmas Bake-off'. This is planned for Easter.
