

Dear Parents / Carers.



It is not long now until Wednesday when we will be welcoming the children back into school. All the measures we have put in place are designed to minimise the chance of transmitting COVID-19 but also to keep the children happily learning and interacting with their peers.





The children will be organised into protective class bubbles. The bubbles of children will not be mixing at any point during the school day. We have also limited the number of different adults that the children will come into contact with.

Start and Finish times

These are staggered so that we can keep the children to their class bubbles and that you are able to maintain social distancing whilst on the playground. We politely ask that you keep to the LEFT whilst walking along pathways and that you make a quick departure from the playground as soon as you are able to do so.

If you are waiting with your child please maintain a good distance from the line of children. Unfortunately those quick messages that can usually be given when you hand over your child to their teacher will need to be sent to the school office by email or by telephone.

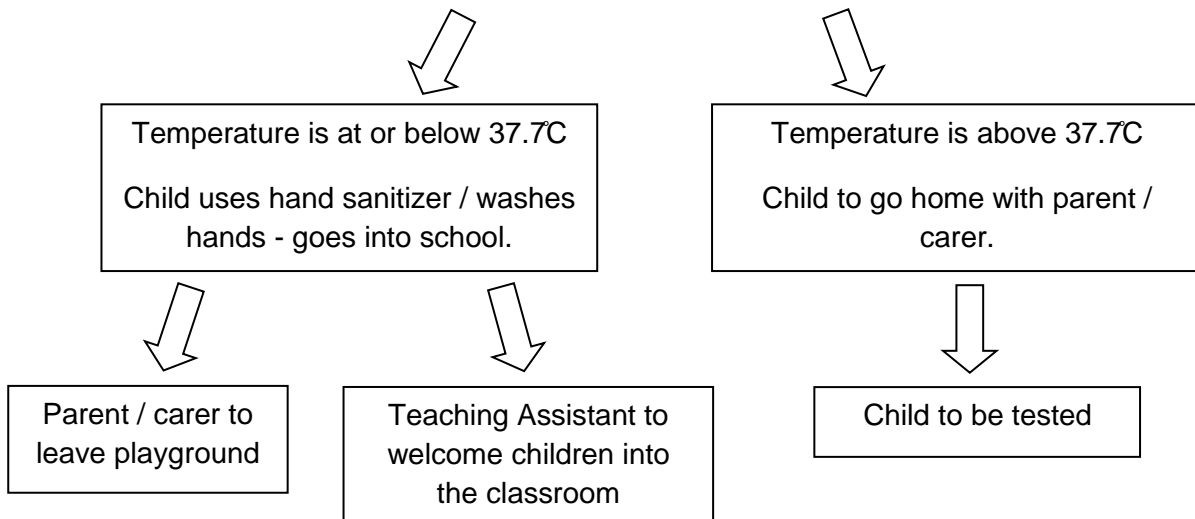
Year 3	9.05	Main playground Children to go straight to their usual lines ready to come into school.	Parents to wait close to the corner of the playground near the traversing wall and trees.	3.25
Year 4	8.55	Using the old main entrance. This is the door at the bottom of the steps leading to the new main entrance. Children to line up along the pathway. Once children have entered school, parents to leave through the car park. 	Parents to wait along the wall / windows by the kitchen that leads to the new main entrance. The children will be released from the old main entrance once the teacher can see the parent / carer. 	3.15
Year 5	9.05	Children to line up along the wall leading to the Y5 fire exit. 	Parents to wait on the playground or grass closest to the outdoor classroom. Children will exit from classroom fire door.	3.25
Year 6	8.55	Children to line up along the wall leading to the Y6 fire exit. 	Exit for children is through the Y6 fire exit.	3.15

Entering the building

Lunches

The children will be provided with either a hot or cold grab bag. They will be able to make their choices of which lunch they would prefer in the usual way. The children will eat in the classroom (in their protective bubbles) and will be supervised by an adult, who works regularly with their bubble. Prior to eating all surfaces will be sanitised, and the nature of a grab bag is that it is not reused thereby mitigating against the risk of transmission of the virus. We hope to resume a lunch time service where the children are seated in the dining hall as soon as the guidance and risk assessments enable us to do so.

We would like to thank you for your support and cooperation with the measures we are putting in place. These will be reviewed on a regular basis and adjusted as guidance changes and also how it works best for the children in our school.
