We will now share our agenda with you.

An agenda tells you what we talked about and the decisions we made.

This was our first meeting since December because of the lockdown. First of all we looked at feedback from some of the suggestion boxes that we had made and we discussed these ideas.

Some of the children asked if it was possible to use the netball posts again and hula hoops. Mrs Kirby said that she would speak to Mr Brotherton about using them.

Many questions arose about the new playground boxes with new equipment in. Some classes felt that they did not have the same number of resources as other classes. We discussed this and it appears that some classes have more of one item than another. The school councillors agreed that they would meet at tomorrow morning break and make sure that all the equipment is fairly distributed between each of the class boxes.

School Councillors asked if it was possible now that the weather is better if children can now play on the top playing field at lunchtime. Mrs Kirby said that she would check with Mr Burrows and Mr Brotherton to ensure that the field is being checked each day as there are lots of rabbit holes in the field. If it is safe, Mrs Kirby will look to see on the rota if children can play on the field when the weather is good and we have enough supervisors to help.

Football may now be played within class bubbles. We discussed about how this could happen with our current rotas in place. It could be having football at lunchtime but not in playtimes or allocating certain days to football. Some children do not want to play football and they need space to use on the playground whilst others are playing a match.

Mrs Kirby looked at the rota and found that the raised area near the tree area outside is free each day, so children could use this area for football, so long as there is an adult helper who is close by. Mrs Kirby will email teachers and lunchtime staff to inform them and this will start next week on lunchtimes only. This will not clash with children using the assault course.
