Count up to 20

- ✓ Count on and back to 20
- ✓ One more than and one less than numbers up to 10
- ✓ Add and subtract one digit numbers to 10, including zero.

Key vocabulary:

One, two, three...

More than

Less than

By the end of this term, children should know these facts. The aim is for ALL children to be able to recall these facts instantly.

Top Tips

The secret to success is practising little and often. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? You don't need to practise them all at once: perhaps you could have a fact of the day. If you would like more ideas, please speak to your child's teacher.

Use practical resources – count out actual objects e.g. buttons, counters, pasta etc.

Make a number poster – eg a train where each carriage is number.

Practise – counting up to 20 initially, once secure count back from 20 in 1s

Ask the question, what is one more than? What is one less than?

Put into real life scenario e.g. If I give you one more apple how many will you have?
