## **Staying Safe at School Survey**

Every year, we ask the children about their feelings towards their safety in school, their happiness, their well-being and their friendships. We carefully analyse the results and ensure subsequent 'actions' are put in place to ensure we develop aspects of our provision for children who have commented with uncertainty towards a statement.

The results for Bramham Primary School were overwhelmingly positive and left us with only a couple of areas to further develop in school:

#### 'I know what the ethos of my school is and where to find it if I'm unsure.'

<u>Actions following survey results:</u> (The majority of these children were in Year 1)

- A greater emphasis to be placed on the ethos statements and what these mean through the launch mornings and exit days at the beginning and end of each half term.
- Greater focus during assembly provision in each key stage and in class-based assemblies.
- Revised 'Learning for Life' throughout Federation implemented and linked to ethos and assembly.



New Learning for Life re-launched for September 2017—more to follow!

#### 100% of the children agreed with the majority of our other statements including (sample):

- There is an adult in my school who I can talk to if I feel worried about anything.
- Most people in my class are friendly and kind
- I am safe in school because the children try to follow our school rules.
- Bullying is taken seriously in my school.
- I understand that bullying is wrong and hurtful.

In response to Parent Questionnaires, we are currently writing a new Homework Policy which will be completed and ratified by Governors early next academic year. I will be writing to you and sharing this new policy and any changes.

#### **Bramham in Bloom**

We were honoured to start the tour of Beautiful Bramham on Wednesday 5th July when we welcomed Britain in Bloom judges to Bramham Primary School. The judges loved our outdoor space and were particularly thrilled with the planned proposals for the Outdoor Classroom as designed by one of our very talented parents, Michelle Walker, a landscape architect.
