You arrive to school via the student entrance. You will


be greeted by SLT (Senior Leadership Team) who will do a

If you are missing uniform the year team will help get you borrow uniform for the day. The uniform is brought back at the end of the day to your head of year.


Once in school you can head to

and your form tutor.



including the basketball courts, the heart space


and canteen.

You should use this time to visit the toilet and get ready for your next lessons.


Period 3 and 4
