Dear Parents/Carers,

Happy new year to you all! I hope you had a lovely Christmas holiday and were able to spend some valuable and memorable time with your families.

Attached are the significant dates for the Spring Term. Hopefully this gives you plenty of time to make arrangements so you are able to attend. Please keep the copy safe at home so you can refer to it. I do want to draw your attention to a couple of things that are coming up in the near future:

1. Parent Workshop on Anxiety (23rd January 6.00pm)

We have asked our Counsellors (Turn the Page) to run a workshop for you to enable you to support children with anxiety. As we know since Covid, this is something that is becoming more prevalent and needs addressing. A letter has already been sent home but if you would like to book a place please contact the school office (it is limited to 30 places).

2. Curriculum Open Session (2nd February 9.15am)

Another chance for you to come in and see your child learning in the classroom. These sessions have proved very popular and I know from your feedback you appreciate the opportunity to see lessons in progress (no booking needed, just turn up).

Just a couple of reminders to finish:

Absences – please follow the absence procedure if your child is going to be off school. This is to contact the school office on the morning of the absence. Some parents are messaging teachers on Dojo, when teaching the class teachers do not always check Dojo straight away.



Jewellery – In our uniform policy it clearly states ‘on health and safety grounds, we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school. The exceptions to this rule are single stud earrings, and watches, which we ask the children to remove for any PE / Games or physical activities. They must be able to remove them by themselves, or not wear them at all.’

Wet weather days – As you will have noticed this week at drop off we had to make alternative arrangements as the paths and playgrounds were so flooded. Thank you all for your co-operation, it was appreciated. If this happens again (very likely) we will use the entrances at the front of school and the Studio entrance for Y1 which seem to be least affected.

Parking – Ormerod Close is for pedestrians only at drop off and pick up times. For the safety of our children and the local residents please do not drive or park on Ormerod Close at these times.
