Dear Parents/Carers,

As we near the end of half term, I would like to thank you all for your vigilance, understanding and patience in getting all children safely back to school. It has not gone unnoticed that you as parents are supporting the school with ensuring all measures sited in the risk assessment are being implemented e.g. one parent to drop off/collect, arriving on time and leaving promptly at designated points, observing social distancing etc. We have been fortunate in our school community that no children have tested positive so we have not had to close any bubbles. Please be reassured if this does happen we have measures in place.

Over half term, school will still need to be contacted if there is a positive case. We will need to identify close contacts and ask families to self-isolate in the same way we would during term time. Please let us know immediately by emailing to:

These emails will be monitored daily and appropriate action will be taken in line with the school risk assessment.

Remote Learning

Attached with this letter is our 'live lesson protocols.' If individual children are isolating we are using Class Dojo as a platform for the teachers to set work. Please ensure your child can access Class Dojo or contact us if you need a new QR code. If a class bubble has to isolate we intend to use "Microsoft Teams' to implement some live lessons (see protocols) as well as setting work on Class Dojo. It is important that children have contact with the teacher and feedback can be given directly and in a timely manner. I am really pleased that a lot of parents have taken up the option of a 'Teams' meeting for parents evening. If successful, this could be a future avenue for us for events such as parent workshops etc.
