



Stockport Scheme of Music Overview EYFS and KS1.

The scheme of music is written as 3 complete units of 6-7 lessons (Autumn 1, Spring 1 and Summer 1) which have detailed lesson plans and resources. The remaining 2-3 terms are left for singing and musical appreciation which is designed to fit in with school productions / Christmas shows etc. This also allows for class teachers to break lessons down into smaller chunks, add in additional lessons or revisit prior learning as needed.
