Please support us in creating a safe environment by following our travel safety protocol

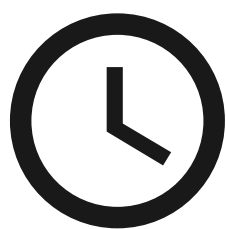
If you, or a member of your household becomes unwell and presents with: a high temperature, a new or continuous cough, or a change or loss to their sense of smell or taste, you must not leave your home and should contact 111 for advice. Please also call the school office to update us.

1) USE THE DESIGNATED LOCATIONS TO DROP OFF AND COLLECT YOUR CHILD

Your child will be met by a member of staff at their designated gate. Please ensure that you are observing social distancing at these points.



2) ARRIVE AT YOUR DESIGNATED POINT ON TIME AND LEAVE PROMPTLY AFTER DROP OFF/COLLECTION



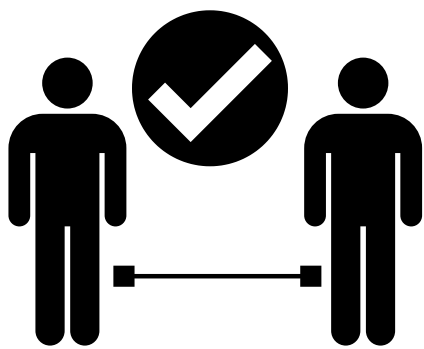
Staff will escort pupils from and to their designated points. We will be unable to admit pupils to school if they are late. Whilst staff can comfort upset children, they will be unable to separate them from their parents.

3) ONLY ONE PARENT/CARER AT A TIME AT THE DESIGNATED POINTS

If you have other children who are unable to stay at home then they may come with you to school. They will not be admitted to the building and should adhere to social distancing guidelines.



4) KEEP A 2 METRE DISTANCE BETWEEN YOURSELF AND OTHER PARENTS



This is important to keep yourself, your child and other families safe.

5) WALK TO SCHOOL

This will ensure maximum social distancing for pupils in transit.

If you do have to drive then please be mindful of other families and children in your proximity. As start times are staggered, it is important that you reach your point at the correct time.
