Please support us in creating a safe environment by following our travel safety protocol

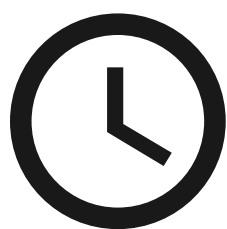
If you, or a member of your household becomes unwell and presents with: a high temperature, a new or continuous cough, or a change or loss to their sense of smell or taste, you must not leave your home and should contact 111 for advice. Please also call the school office to update us.

1) USE THE DESIGNATED LOCATIONS TO DROP OFF AND COLLECT YOUR CHILD

Your child will be met by a member of staff at their designated gate and at their designated time. Please ensure that you are observing social distancing at these points.



2) ARRIVE AT YOUR DESIGNATED POINT ON TIME AND LEAVE PROMPTLY AFTER DROP OFF/COLLECTION



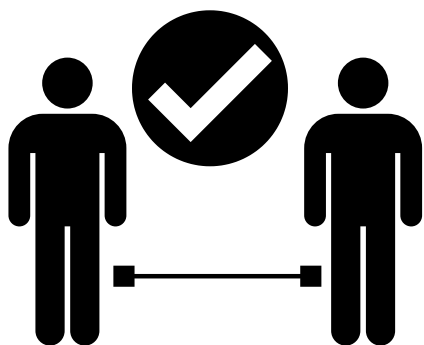
Staff will escort pupils from and to their designated points. Late pupils will be admitted through the school office; please endeavour to be on time. Whilst staff can comfort upset children, they will be unable to separate them from their parents.

3) ONLY ONE PARENT/CARER AT A TIME AT THE DESIGNATED POINTS

If you are travelling with a buggy, please use our 'buggy zone' in the front car park to help ease congestion on the pavement and allow for social distancing.



4) KEEP A 2 METRE DISTANCE BETWEEN YOURSELF AND OTHER PARENTS



This is important to keep yourself, your child and other families safe.

5) WALK TO SCHOOL

This will ensure maximum social distancing for pupils in transit.

If you do have to drive then please be mindful of other families and children in your proximity. Please follow our one way system if you are using a Clapgate entrance and do not park on the yellow lines in front of school.
