Nursery Reminder

This is a quick reminder that **all** nursery sessions will need to be booked and paid for in advance using the My Child at School app to ensure we have the required staff needed. If you need help to do this please pop in to the office where we will be happy to help!

How to Select Nursery Sessions

On the My Child at School app, please go to Wrap Around Care and select either Nursery Morning or Nursery Afternoon. You will also be able to book Breakfast Club and After School Care from this section, should you require them. These sessions are available at an additional cost. Breakfast club is £2.50 a session and After School Care is £5.00 a session.

After selecting Morning or Afternoon, you will then be able to choose the days your child will attend.

Important Booking Information.

To ensure we can staff the nursery safely and meet required ratios, all bookings must be made by the Friday prior to the week required.

Please select either of the following:

- N.AMF/N.15 – if your child receives 15 hours funding
- N.30 – if your child receives 30 hours funding
- N.AM / N.PM– if you are paying for a session

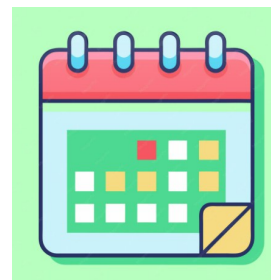

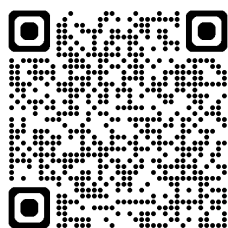

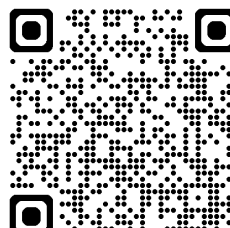
Support for your child's Health
