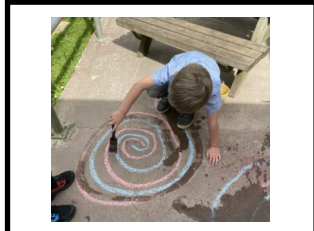

## Class News

### Nursery

This week in nursery, the children have been exploring mini beasts again. They enjoyed looking closely at snails and used their gross motor skills to help clean the big snails off our playground carefully with water and brushes.



### Class 1

This week in maths, we have been learning about fractions. We played fraction bingo and organised counters into groups of half, thirds and quarters. Reception have been creating pictures with wooden and plastic shapes, also paper ones they have cut out themselves.

Construction is well underway with the children making their animal sculptures in the style of Michelle Reader. When finished, they will be entered into the Bromyard art competition - Art walk taking place 4<sup>th</sup> - 19<sup>th</sup> July.

On the My Child at School app, please go to Wrap Around Care and select either Nursery Morning or Nursery Afternoon. You will also be able to book Breakfast Club and After School Care from this section, should you require them. These sessions are available at an additional cost. Breakfast club is £2.50 a session and After School Care is £5.00 a session.

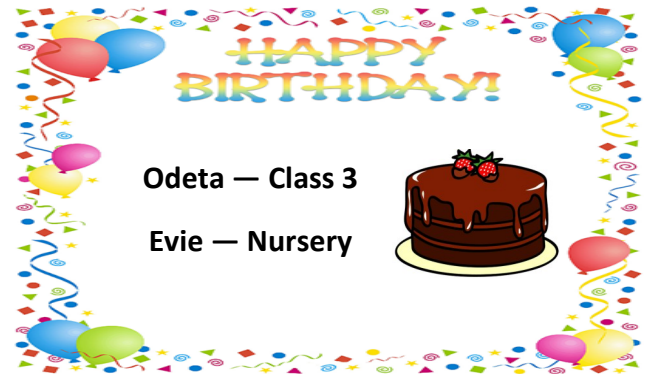
After selecting Morning or Afternoon, you will then be able to choose the days your child will attend.

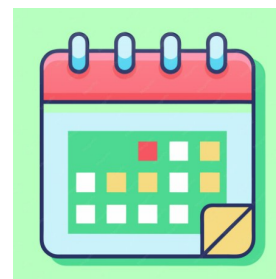

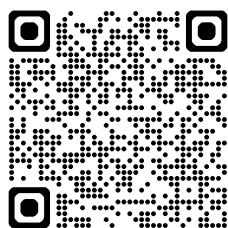

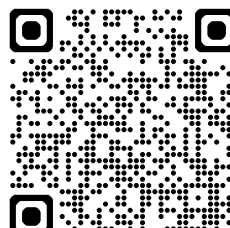


## Support for your child's Health
