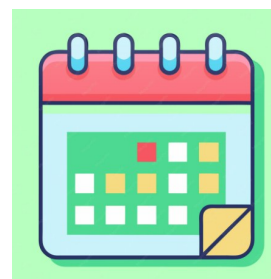

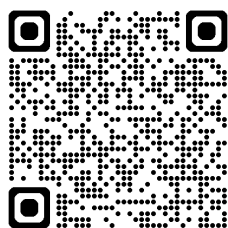

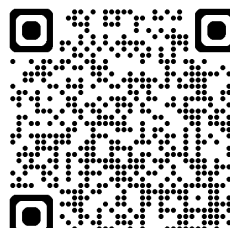
Support for your child's Health
