This week Nursery have been drawing maps to their house and on Thursday a fun music session with Wendy.



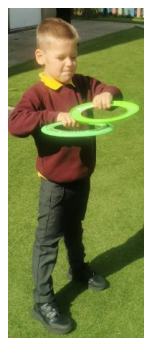
Class 3

On the My Child at School app, please go to Wrap
Around Care and select either Nursery Morning or
Nursery Afternoon. You will also be able to book Break-
fast Club and After School Care from this section,
should you require them. These sessions are available
at an additional cost. Breakfast club is £2.50 a session
and After School Care is £5.00 a session.

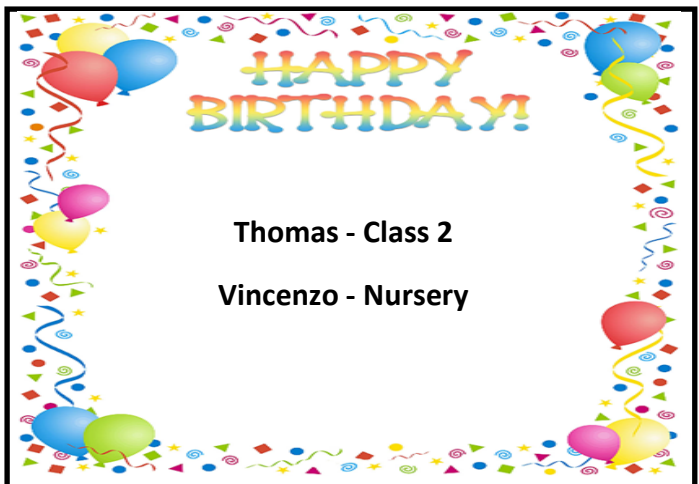
After selecting Morning or Afternoon, you will then be

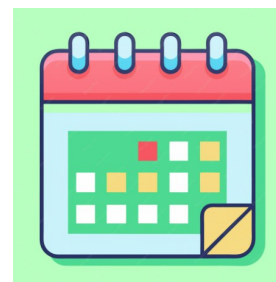

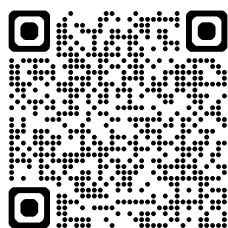

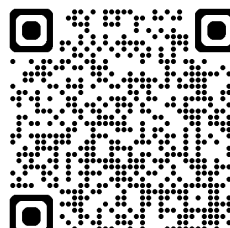
Support for your child's Health
