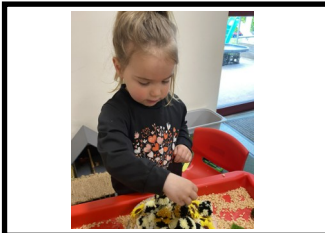

This week in science, the children have been learning about plants we can eat. We had fun tasting a variety of herbs, some were liked more than others, and we did see some amusing faces being made.

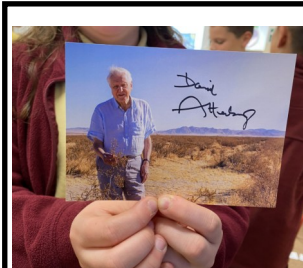
Class 2—Ice cream Friday £1

How to Select Nursery Sessions

On the My Child at School app, please go to Wrap Around Care and select either Nursery Morning or Nursery Afternoon. You will also be able to book Breakfast Club and After School Care from this section, should you require them. These sessions are available at an additional cost. Breakfast club is £2.50 a session and After School Care is £5.00 a session.

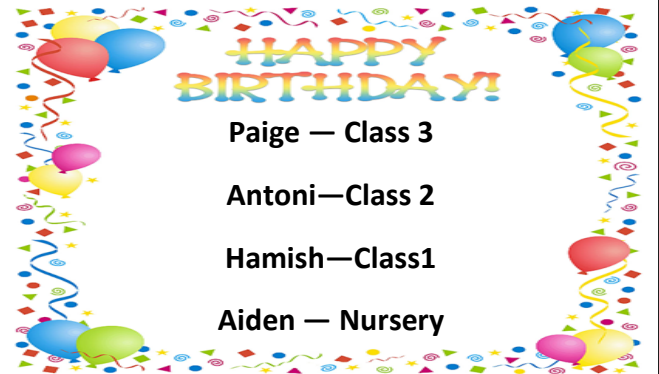
After selecting Morning or Afternoon, you will then be able to choose the days your child will attend.

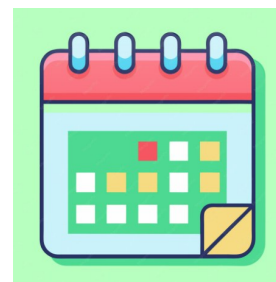

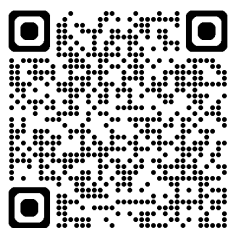

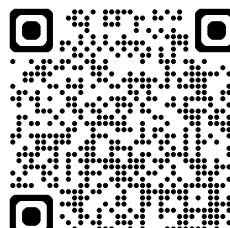
Support for your child's Health
