A broad and balanced curriculum is designed to meet the individual needs and interests of all our students. We want to ensure they study a balanced range of subjects, which will equip them to function effectively in a rapidly changing world.

We place a strong emphasis on traditional GCSE and A Level subjects, which are valued highly by prospective employers and universities. The vast majority of our students attain top grades, while a high percentage achieve the English Baccalaureate (EBacc).

At BRGS, learning does not take place exclusively in the classroom. We offer many extra-curricular activities, including one of the largest Duke of Edinburgh's Award schemes in the county.

Enrichment opportunities include instrumental music tuition, sports teams, orienteering, drama, computing activities, religious and debating groups. Students can take part in a wide range of educational visits, both in the UK and abroad, which provide an opportunity for curriculum enhancement and broader cultural awareness.
