

**Sub-committees of the Governing Body - Terms of Reference**

Curriculum Sub-committee

1. The Curriculum Sub-committee is a committee established by the Governing Body “in accordance with the Academy Trust’s Articles of Association”.
2. The curriculum comprises all learning and other experiences that the school provides for its pupils.
3. The purpose of the Sub-committee is to evaluate teaching and learning, achievement and standards and review all aspects of the curriculum.

REMIT OF THE COMMITTEE

4. To consider, agree and monitor the implementation of a curriculum policy
5. To ensure that pupils receive a broad and balanced curriculum
6. In collaboration with staff, to provide information to the Governing Body about how the curriculum is taught, evaluated and monitored
7. To monitor and review information about school performance and report according to statutory requirements, and to advise the Governing Body
8. To review, adopt and monitor policies as determined by the school master list of policies”.
9. To advise Finance and Staffing Committees on the relative funding priorities necessary to deliver the curriculum.
10. The Sub-committee shall be formally required to report any action taken or decision made to the next governing body meeting.

MEMBERSHIP

11. The Sub-committee shall comprise of at least four members, including a teacher governor, the Headteacher. Assistant Heads in charge of the school curriculum will be invited as and when requires. Non-governors may be co-opted onto the Sub-committee.
12. The quorum for a meeting of the Sub-committee shall be two members or one third of the membership (rounded up to a whole number), whichever is the greater.
13. The Curriculum Committee is a committee established by the Governing Body in accordance with the Academy Trust’s Articles of Association”.
14. The committee shall have regard to all matters relating to access under the Disability Discrimination Act 1995.
