Resort Overview


- This is a great resort for schools with doorstep skiing and accommodation only 50 metres from the lift and ski school meeting place.

- Ski Fit is within walking distance and takes place first thing on the Monday morning
- Groups will be taught by fully qualified instructors

Sleep

- Last year we had room sizes of 3-5 in a room.
- Children will choose three children on a list and we guarantee they will get at least one of them in their room.
- Sleep routines – night lights, masks, book, teddy etc.
- Adult rooms are close to the children, e.g. along the corridor and all children will know where we are.
- Children can come and see an adult at any time!

- 19.00 – 20.00 Evening activity
- 20.00 – 21.00 Bed time routine
- 21.00 Bed time





What do you need to do?

- Sign up on arbor for the trip by the end of February (this secures our early discount price).

Ski Trip Check List

Ski Items (vinted, facebook market place)

- Salopettes
- Ski jacket / coat
- Fleeces / jumpers that can be worn as layers under the ski jacket
- Ski socks
- Ski gloves
- Ski goggles
- Thermals (long sleeve tops & bottoms)
- Warm hat (ideally one that can be worn under a helmet)
- Neck warmer/snood
- Top tip: Layering items under ski outer wear is key to keeping warm on the mountain!*
- Sun cream (minimum factor 30)
- SPF lip balm

Clothing

- Nightwear
- Underwear
- Sturdy outdoor snow or walking boots / footwear with a good grip (ideally waterproof)
- Comfortable lighter weight outdoor shoes E.g. trainers
- Sets of clothes for evenings

Other essentials

- Wash bag & toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, deodorant, brush/comb etc.)
- Sunglasses
- Labelled plastic bags for wet/dirty/spare clothes
- Small Torch
- Book
