- Signed Tenancy Agreement or Exchange of Contracts/Completion document

Plus at least one of these:

- Child/Working Tax Credit/Child
 Benefit/JSA/Disability Benefit Letter or Statement
- Driving Licence











Proof that <u>your child</u> lives at the same address can be any of:

- Doctor/Hospital appointment letter in the child's name
- Savings account or bank statement in the child's
- Child benefit statement

• Letter from their nursery/preschool/current school

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- Schedule of Motor Insurance
- Utility bills such as Gas/Water/Electric/Sky/Virgin Media/BT/Broadband etc
- Payslip

Please note that documents should be dated within the last three months and only original documents can be accepted.
