I am writing to confirm that we have received your acceptance of the space that your child was offered at Bridge & Patricxbourne CEP School. If we require any further information in this regard then Morny Starling (Admissions Officer) will be in touch soon.

We have a great many children joining us from different nurseries across Canterbury and I know that the teachers would appreciate the opportunity to speak to the nursery staff about your children to gain an initial impression of the children and allow for a professional discussion about any matters that may impact upon a successful start to school. It would be very helpful if you could email Mrs Starling and let her know which nursery your child attends so that we can make contact over the next few weeks.
