Additional Support for Vulnerable Children

In order to support those children who may have additional needs, as well as those who have been significantly impacted by the coronavirus outbreak, we are creating a small team to support Mrs Long in ensuring that all children continue to thrive academically and emotionally.

Mrs Pearman will be working primarily in Year R and 1, splitting her time between Forest School and supporting children in the development of their speech and language. Mrs Pearson will be based in Year 4 and you will know that she has a wealth of knowledge and experience in specialist learning interventions (as well as being a brilliant Sports Coach!) Mrs McLean will also be working across the school supporting children with dyslexic tendencies as this is her specialism.

I'm also pleased to welcome Mrs Amy Kirk to our Bridge staff team. As a Speech & Language Therapist, she will be a great addition to our team

Year 1 Showcase and Year 6 Production

Over the next few weeks we have our Year 1 children showcasing their learning (as an alternative to another nativity performance) and the Year 6 children performing the School of Rock. It is very disappointing that current COVID restrictions mean that we are only able to host a very small number of parents but we have to work within the controls that are imposed upon us.

Prior to attending, we will be asking all parents to take a Lateral Flow Test and not attend if they are displaying any symptoms. It is also a legal requirement that face coverings are worn at all times (unless you are exempt) and sanitising stations will also be available for parents. We will also be keeping records of all attendees for the purposes of Track & Trace.

The evening performances of the Year 6 production will, understandably, be more popular but, if you can attend the afternoon performances, it would be very helpful. Kent Test

Is your child currently in Year 5? Are you wanting them to go to a Grammar School starting in September 2022? If yes then registration for the Kent Test is open now.

Register at <u>www.kent.gov.uk/ola</u> before the closing date of 1st July 2021 Please remember to include your child's full name and their current school as part of the information you provide.

You must submit your registration to us before 1st July for your child to be able to sit the test in September. The Kent Test covers all Grammar Schools within Kent County Council. If you wish your child to go to a Grammar School in Medway, Bromley, Bexley etc then you need to check with those authorities how you go about registering for that.

Kent Test Dates are as follows:

Children at a Kent Primary = Thursday 9th September 2021 (in their Primary School) Tests are due to take place in September 2021, and we will continue to monitor whether any adjustments are required to the Kent Test process this year in the light of COVID-19. Please register as usual if you want your child considered for a place at Kent grammar school in September 2022.
