Dear Parents/Carers,

I trust that everyone has had a positive first week— as is standard, the first week of the term has been marked with an improvement in the weather and we've had glorious sunshine for the majority of the week!

#### Drop-Off & Pick-Up Routine

Next week our Year R children will be starting school full-time. In the mornings, if you are dropping off a Year R child, please could we ask that you arrive at school no earlier than 8.45am if at all possible. By this time, most of the children and parents have come through and this will mean an easier and less stressful time for us all.

In the afternoon, parents of Year R children may collect their children from 3.10pm in order to avoid the rush of other parents. However, the other classes will not be releasing their children until 3.15pm so please do not enter the school premises unless you are collecting a sole Year R child – you will not be able to collect children from other year groups.

Please could I also remind parents that they should not drive down School Road without specific permission from the school. This is to ensure the safety of the children as they walk to and from school.

#### Arbor

We are still experiencing some teething problems with Arbor. Most of the issues we are facing is unfamiliarity with the system but we seem to be getting there. I was heartened by hearing from another teacher (who is also a parent at Bridge) that Arbor is the 'best thing ever'. 
