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On a more positive note, I'm extremely pleased that we will be welcoming Mr Miles back to Bridge School in September – apparently he missed us all too much! He is having to return the leaving present we all got him but he will, once again, be teaching music in the school.

We will also be joined by three new members of staff in September: Miss Ellison will be teaching in Year R and she has a great deal of experience teaching this age group in Kent and London, I have no doubt she will be a great asset to the team.
