#### **✚ Stop, Look, Listen!**

Consider the story of Creation, how God created the earth in the first five days: **Genesis 1 verses 1 - 19**

Offer alternative ways of reminding children of the story, through reading it from the Bible, through watching a video clip, through a power point, etc. Maybe find an outside space to share the story to help children through a sensory approach. Watch the clouds passing overhead, feel the breeze, the warmth of the sun, etc.

Ask children to spend time reflecting on the elements created up to and including the 4<sup>th</sup> day: light, dark, land, water, trees, plants, sun, moon, stars. Of these, which element do they truly appreciate and why?

Share the idea that whilst many things change in our lives, some things can always be relied upon even if they too change in their own ways, such as the sun and moon are always there; water never stops flowing, etc.
