## School Uniform & Lost Property

In order to stop the lost property building up, we will be displaying it in the main playground each Friday. If you have lost anything, please speak to the office to check the cupboard in the week or come to the playground on Fridays.

## Year 6 Residential (Current Year 5 Parents)

Following the Year 5 Meet the Teacher session on Tuesday, I'm aware that some parents are concerned that changing the Year 6 residential to the beginning of the academic year might have an impact on children being able to attend Open Days and Open Evenings for their preferred secondary schools.

The dates we have booked for next year's residential are Monday 28th September to Friday 2nd October.

I understand that it is vitally important that the children move on to the right school for them and I wanted to reassure parents that the reason we chose this particular week was because it did not fall at the same time of the Open Days and Open Evenings of the schools that the children from Bridge School, in the main, attend.

Obviously, we cannot guarantee that secondary schools won't change their dates but if they follow the same pattern as this year:

- **Spires** and **St Anselm's** will have their Open Days and Evenings the week before the residential.
- **Canterbury Academy** will hold their Open Days and Evening the week after the residential.
- **Simon Langton Boys, Simon Langton Girls** and **Barton Court** will have their Open Days and Evenings two weeks after the residential.
- The only local school (that we are aware of) that will hold their Open Days and Evening the week of the residential is **Archbishops**, but they also hold an Open Day on a Saturday.

As I said, we can't guarantee that the secondary schools will follow the same pattern as this year and I certainly would not discourage looking around schools this year in preparation for next year.

Secondary School transition is a stressful time for families and we want to do what we can support you and the children throughout the process. There will be an information session for parents later in the year but, in the meantime, if there is anything that we can do, then please do let us know.

Finally I'd to welcome our three new PTA officers: Rebecca Morgan (Chair), Hayley Steer (Secretary) and Alan Goggin (Treasurer). Over the next couple of weeks they will be meeting the outgoing officers for handover and I'd like to thank Rob Moon, Megan Shirley and Steph Chapman for all their hard work over the years. The PTA has been an incredible support to the school over the years and this year in particular with their support of the school minibuses, the refurbishment of the school library, the development of the Year 1 courtyard and so many other smaller projects.
