Christmas Bazaar (Friday 6th December)

As I mentioned in last week's newsletter, I am very grateful to have received a great deal of parental support for this event and can now share the details and arrangements for the day. When planning this event, we considered the feedback from children and parents about what they liked and what they did not like about previous bazaars.

In the morning

• All children from Years R to 2 will have the opportunity to visit Santa in his grotto for a donation of £1, which should be paid for on the day.

In the afternoon

- There will be games set up in the Year 4 and 5 classrooms for all children to play (these games will only cost 20p each)

School Disco (Friday 6th December)

The KS1 and KS2 Christmas Discos are fast approaching with our very own DJ Moon in charge of the decks! The KS1 disco starts at 5pm and the KS2 disco starts from 6.30pm and both last an hour. Children can be collected and dropped off from the side hall entrance.

Year R and 1 Nativity Performances

The Year R and 1 Nativity will take place on the Thursday 12th (pm) and Friday 13th (am) December.

Seating is always a contentious issue and over the years, there have been many attempts to get this right so that no parents are disadvantaged. Last year we introduced a new system which received positive feedback and so we will be using the same system again.

Each child will be offered two seats initially and these can either be used for the Thursday afternoon performance or the Friday morning performance. **Booking is open now and close on Monday 2nd December at 9am.** After this time, extra seats will be allocated to fill remaining space if there is any. Initially, there will be a maximum of two extra seats permitted. If you ask for eight extra tickets, you will only get two!

Once the seat selection has been completed, we will allocate seating. In order to ensure fairness, this will not be first-come, first-served on the day so there is no need to spend an hour queuing outside. Seating will be allocated randomly.

There is no cost to the nativity but at the end of the performance, there will be a collection for our chosen charity, Save the Children.

Year 2 Nativity Performances

Year 2 will be holding their traditional nativity production in the church on Wednesday 11th and Thursday 12th December (both performances in the morning). We won't be issuing tickets but please could we ask parents to limit themselves to two people per performance so that everyone gets a fair chance. As last year, we won't be selling tickets but there will be a retiring collection with all donations going to the Church Fund.

Who doesn't love a Christmas Jumper? On Friday 13th December, we'll all be getting into the festive spirit by wearing our Christmas Jumpers with a £1 donation to Save the Children.
