All scores for individual responses were averaged to give an overall 'satisfaction score' between 1 and 4.


Each person represents one response.

Over the course of this year, how do you feel the school has done on the key issues from last year?



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



WHAT COULD WE HAVE DONE DIFFERENTLY/BETTER?

We recognise that we can't get everything right for every family all the time, but it's still important to reflect upon actions we could have taken.

- Provided live/video lessons (10 respondents)
- Provide a greater range of curriculum subjects, i.e. History, Geography, French, etc. (5 respondents)
- Provide greater guidance on how to schedule learning throughout the day (4 respondents)
- Arrange class video calls to check in on children and enable them to speak to each other (2 respondents)
- Provide more specific support for children with SEN (2 respondents)

WHAT DO YOU FEEL THE SCHOOL SHOULD FOCUS ON NEXT YEAR?



"Supporting the children to recover from this situation with a huge focus on their mental health and well being, alongside their fitness. If they are happy I'm confident the children will be able to get back to the level they were working at and higher."
