Things you will need:

Glue, tape, scissors, card.

Elastic, or a stick.

Things to decorate your mask.



There are five mask templates included in the pack for you to use. If you want to, make a completely new design of your own.

To print all the templates, print pages 3 to 8.

Tips and Ideas

- When you start making your mask, line-up the eye-holes to match your eyes. You need to be able to see!
- Look for things to decorate the mask. Ribbons, bottle tops, tissue paper, paint, lace, bits of fabric, bubble wrap, wool, sweet wrappers, buttons, shiny things like sequins or foil.
- You can give the mask a theme. Think of things that you like.
- Decorate the mask with different things of similar colours.
- Cut a toilet roll in half and then cut into it with scissors to make a fringe effect.
- Run a ruler down thin strips of coloured paper to create hanging curls, that look like hair.

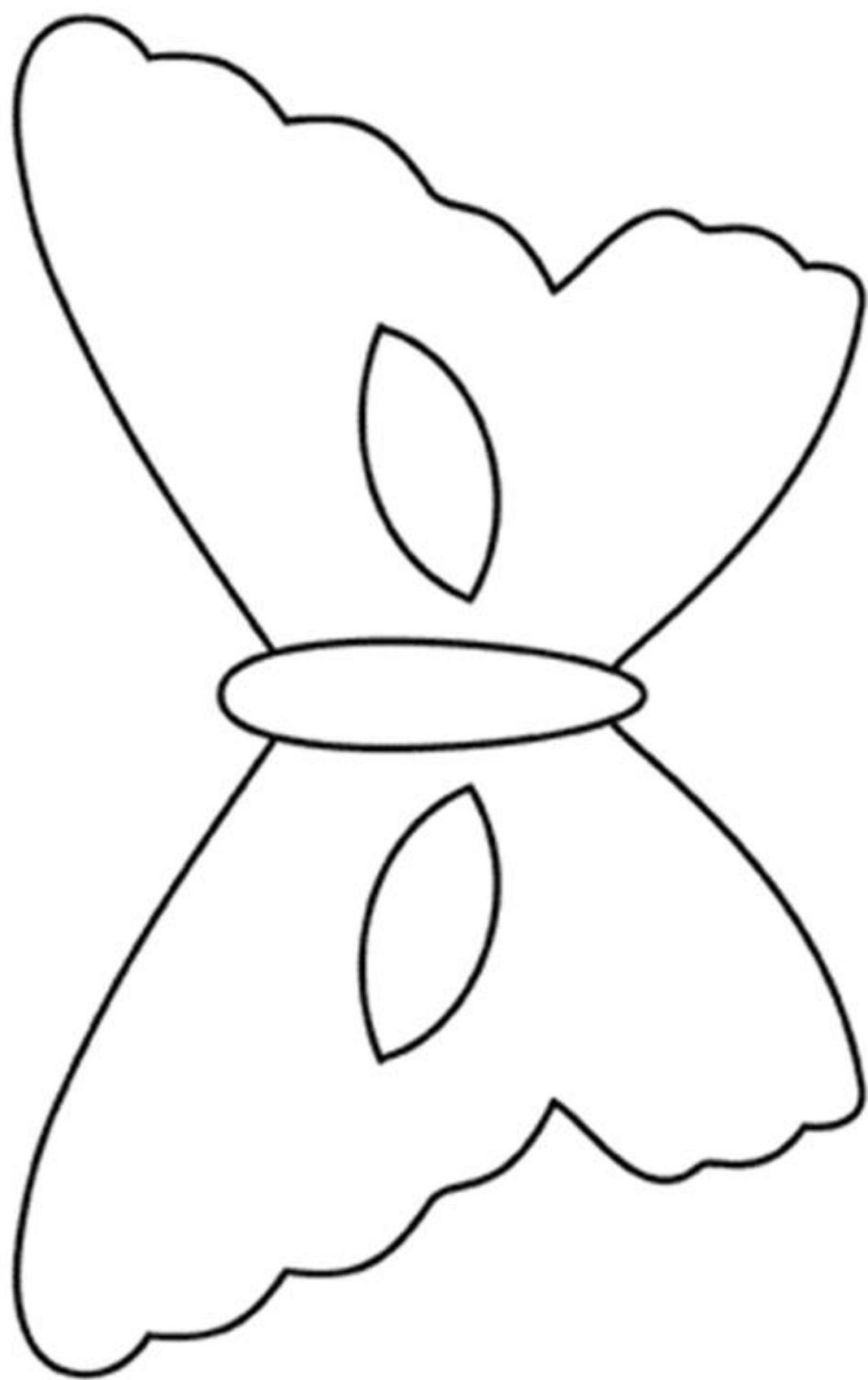

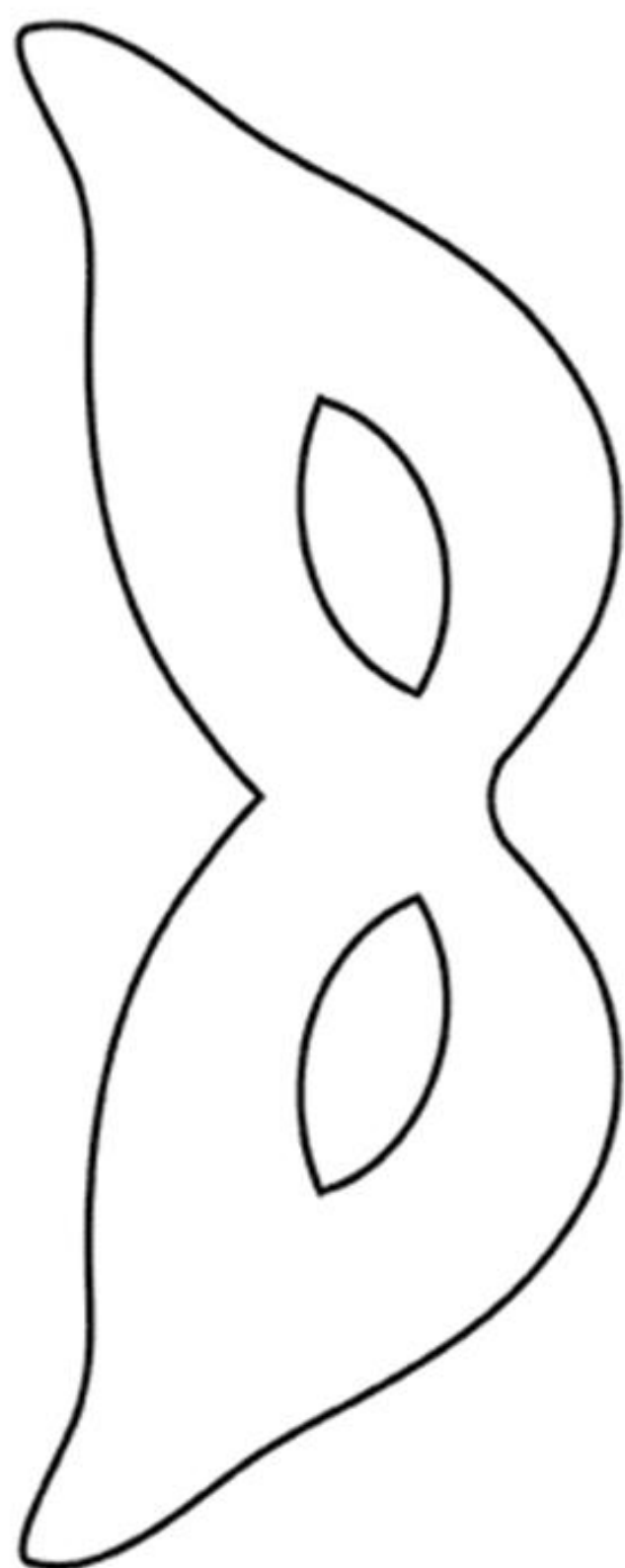

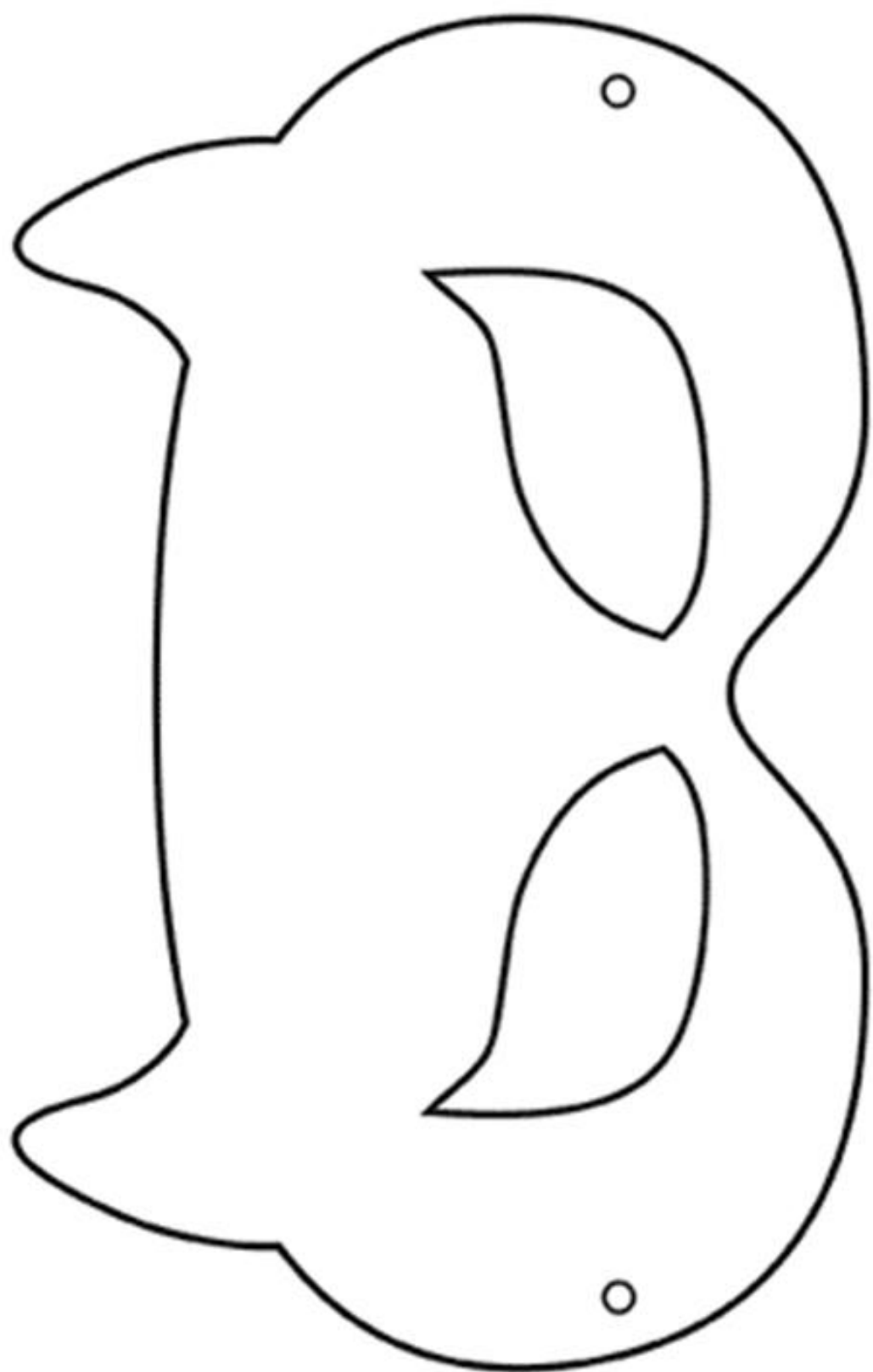
