## **HOW TO BOOK TICKETS** (Please read for further information)

Preferred method of booking is through the Leeds Playhouse website to ensure audience members in your care are seated according to their specific needs.

Carers and support workers are entitled to free tickets, by selecting 'COMPANION  $\,$  -  $\pm0'$  from the drop-down menu.

Please notice that there is also a category for 'WHEELCHAIR USER' which, when selected, will help Leeds Playhouse to best anticipate people's access needs and seat everyone as comfortably as possible. Wheelchair users' spaces are on the flat floor on the front row, and these spaces are very limited, so if this ticket type is needed, please book your seat(s) as soon as possible.

Another category is 'ACCESS'. This is to let Leeds Playhouse know that the person will be seated in a regular theatre seat, yet they may need assistance.

This will also provide an opportunity to discuss any specific access needs of your group members.

An additional charge (currently £2.50) applies to each transaction (regardless of how many tickets are booked).

## This additional charge can be avoided by visiting the Box Office counter at Leeds Playhouse and purchasing your tickets in person.

If you are booking tickets on behalf of a group, the earlier you purchase your tickets, the more choice you will have of where your group can sit, to make the experience as comfortable as possible for all visitors.
