



Brookfields School Uniform Policy

All items of our uniform can be bought in local shops or supermarkets. Items with our school logo such as sweatshirts, cardigans, polo shirts and book bags can be purchased from Gogna School Wear and Sports on Rookery Road, B21 9QU, or via the Gogna website www.gognaschoolwear.co.uk/

Nursery classes

White or sky blue polo shirt / navy blue sweatshirt with logo / navy blue jogging bottoms / black, flat shoes or trainers without laces.

Reception classes

White or sky blue polo shirt / navy blue sweatshirt with logo / navy blue jogging bottoms or charcoal grey trousers / charcoal grey pinafore or skirt / black, flat shoes.

Years 1 to 6

Winter and summer uniform for boys;

White or sky blue polo shirt / navy blue sweatshirt with logo / charcoal grey trousers / flat, black shoes.

Winter uniform for girls;

Flat, black shoes / charcoal grey socks, tights or leggings / white or sky blue polo shirt / navy blue cardigan or sweatshirt with logo / charcoal grey skirt, pinafore or trousers.

Or

Charcoal grey salwar kameez / navy blue or white headscarf or hijab / navy blue cardigan or sweatshirt with logo.

Summer uniform for girls (optional);

Blue gingham summer dress / white socks, white tights or white leggings.

PE uniform for all children (Reception to Year 6);

White t-shirt (<u>not</u> the polo shirt worn daily), navy blue shorts or navy blue jogging bottoms / navy blue sweatshirt / black pumps or plain black trainers.

PE kits are to be kept in school every day in a clearly labelled bag.

Things to remember:

- No drop or hooped earrings or bangles are to be worn in school. Pupils may wear small stud earrings. Sikh children may wear their Kara but it must be covered with an elastic bandage or sweat band for P.E.
- No jewellery, other than that stated above, is allowed in school
- Hairbands, bows and clips must be white, grey or navy no decorative hair accessories
- Any other decisions are based on health and safety grounds
- Please label all items of clothing, including coats, with the child's name
