English

In English, this half term, we will begin by reading and exploring Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. We will be writing character descriptions about the main characters before moving on to newspapers and diary entries about the ticket winners.

Reading

Our class text this half term is 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' by Roald Dahl We will explore the text together and develop our comprehension and inference skills.



Maths-Place Value

This half term's unit builds on previous learning in Year 3 about place value within 1,000. This previous learning introduced children to the concept of counting in 10s, comparing numbers, ordering numbers, and using a number line to 1,000. Children will continue to use these previously learnt skills and apply them when working with 4-digit numbers. Before they start this unit, it is expected that children:

- have a solid understanding of place value within 1,000 from Year 3.
- understand how to count in 10s and 100s.
- can order and compare numbers to 1,000.

Homework – Homework will be set on a Friday and should be returned by Tuesday of the following week.

Reading – Please ensure that your children are reading every night at home and their reading diary is signed to reflect this. Levelled reading books will be changed weekly. Children can change their library books (reading for pleasure) when they have finished reading.
