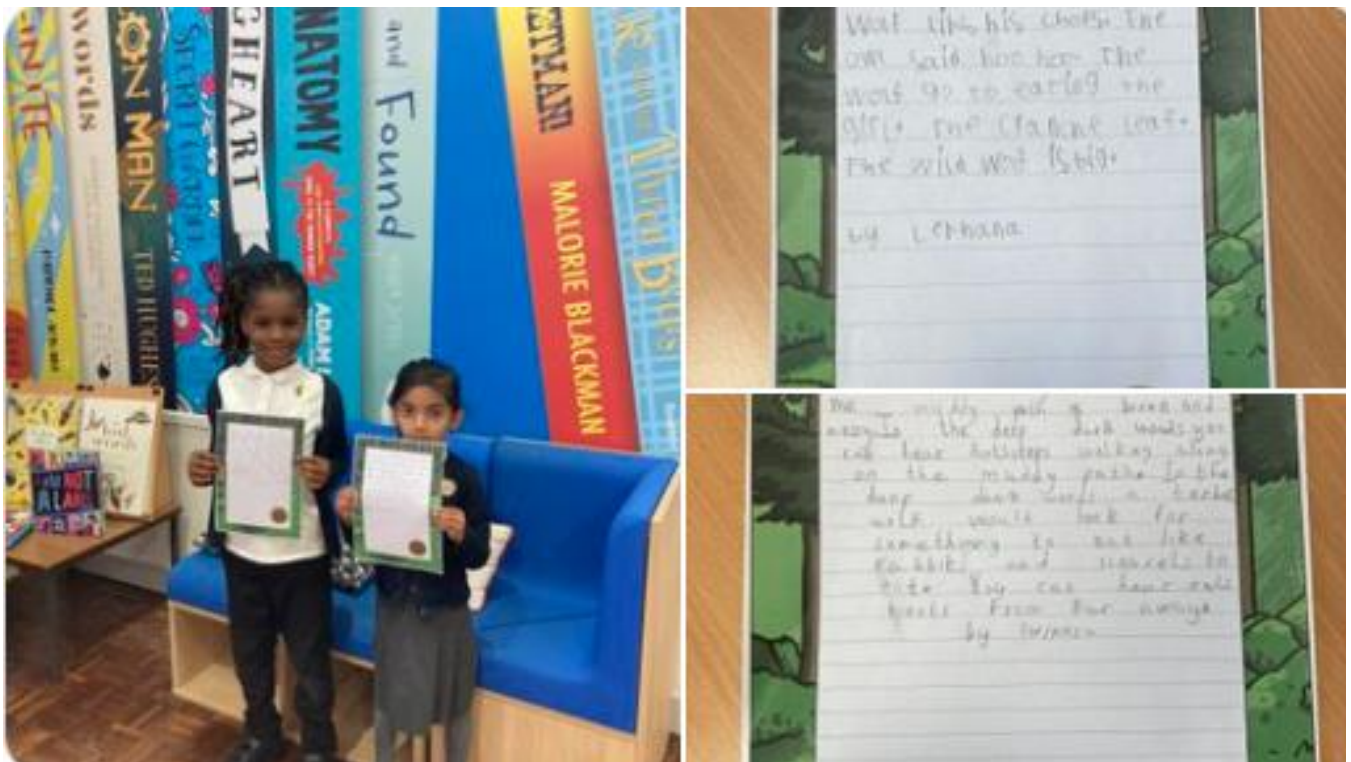
Our after school netball club started this week, led by a coach affiliated to England Netball.

Children have been working really hard in lessons. See below some of the excellent writing that Year 1 have produced.

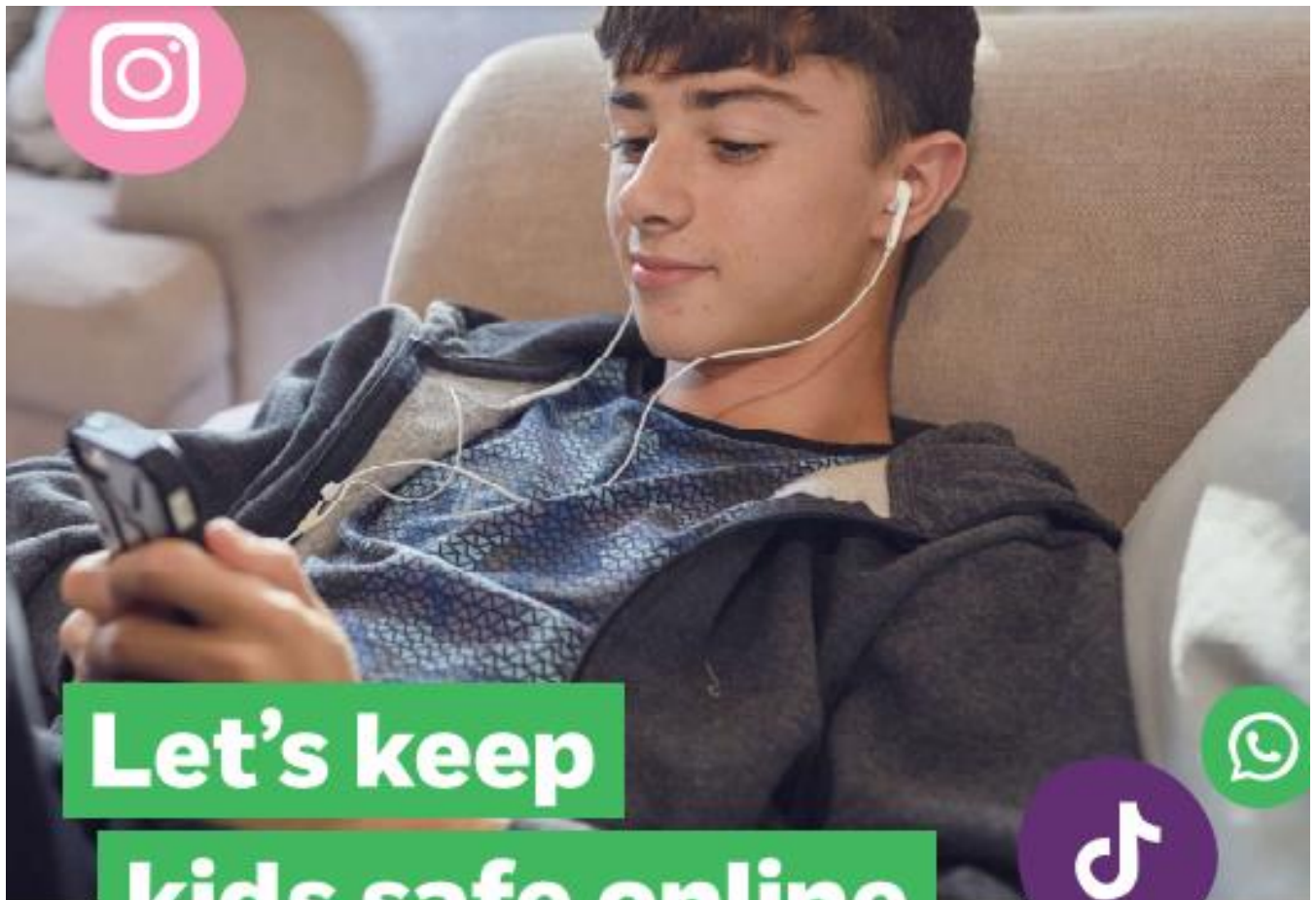
Keep an eye on our key dates list for this term, we will continue to add in planned events each week.

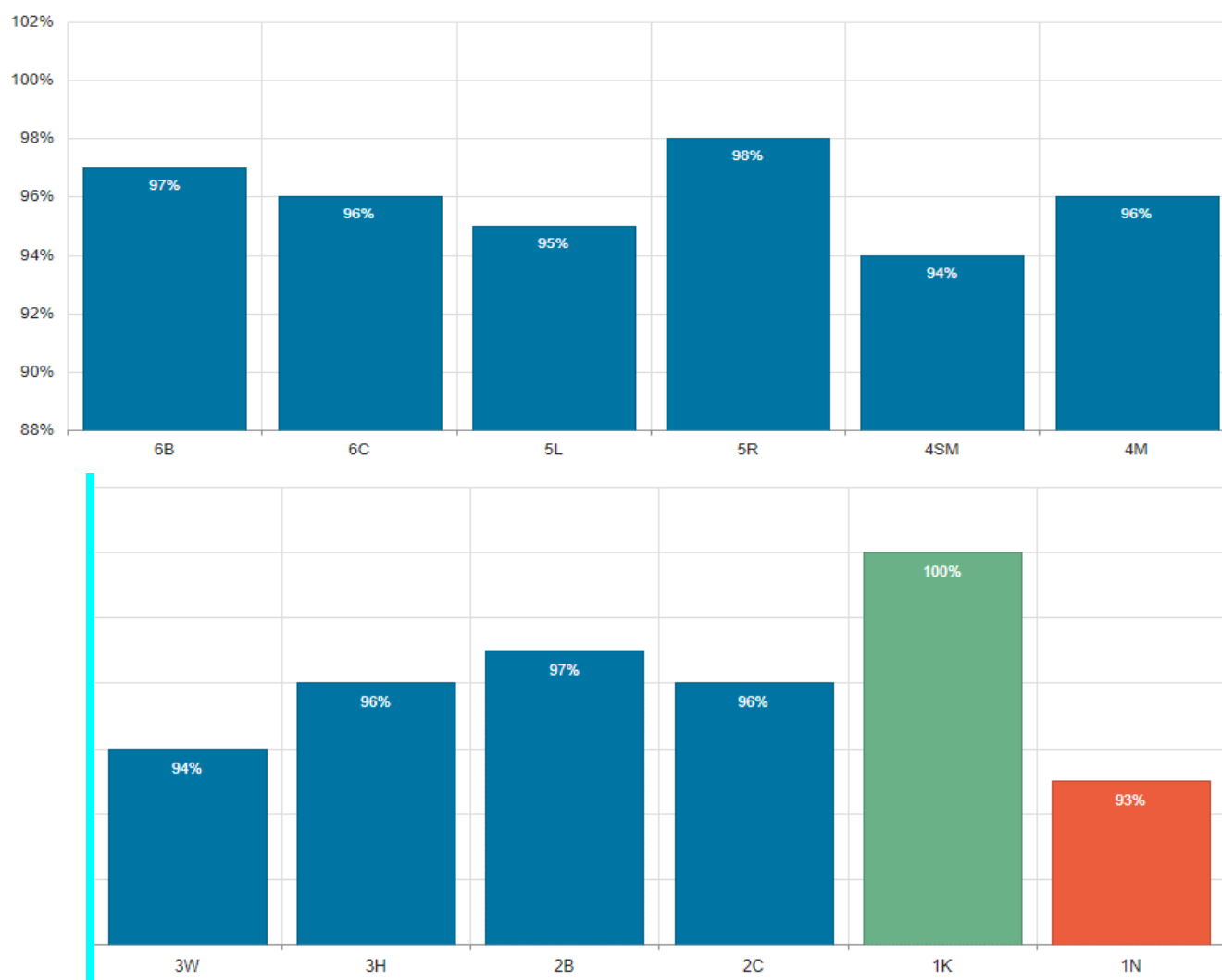
