It is really important that you apply on time. If you apply late you are less likely to get offered a place at any of your preferred schools. Applications received after the 31 October 2023 will be classed as late applications and will not be processed until after the offer of places on 1 March 2024.

APPLYING FOR SECONDARY SCHOOL

If your child is in Year 6, you will need to apply for their secondary school place by **Tuesday 31**st **October 2023**. It is important you make your application on time – you are less likely to get your preferred school if your application is late.

HOW TO APPLY

- · Apply online at Birmingham City Council
- · Complete a short form add up to 6 schools
- Check each school's admissions criteria in case your child needs to:
 - o take an entrance exam
 - o have a particular religious background
 - o live within a certain distance
- · You can access free wifi at your local library.
