In our Spring Meeting, Governors were pleased to ratify the new school timings which take effect from September 2024. Our wrap-around care, Kidz Club, run by Mrs Lockhart will continue and prices will not be affected: Breakfast Club will start at 8am and run to 8:45 and After-School Club will start at 3:15 and run to 5:30. I should remind parents that Kidz Club is a privately run business, managed by Mrs Lockhart, and indeed has its own Ofsted inspection separate to the school (graded Good in November 2022) and any enquiries you may have about Club should be directed to Mrs Lockhart.
