#### WHAT YOU CAN DO TO HELP

- Families should not take holidays that require your children to miss school. Try to line up holidays with the school's timetable. The same goes for doctor's appointments.
- Set a regular bed time and morning routine.
- Make sure that when the lights go out, so do the cell phones, video games and computers.
- Lay out clothes and pack backpacks the night before.
- Don't let your child stay at home unless they are truly sick. Keep in mind complaints of a stomach ache or headache can be a sign of anxiety and not a reason to stay home.
- If your child seems anxious about going to school, talk to teachers, learning mentors or other parents for advice on how to make them feel comfortable and excited about learning.
- Develop back-up plans for getting to school if something comes up. Call on a family member, a neighbour, another parent or phone the school.
- Above all, set an example for your child. Show him or her that attendance matters to you and that you won't allow an absence unless someone is truly sick.
