If your child is going to be absent from school, contact must be made first thing that morning and each day thereafter. Contact can be made via our Brookside school website under 'Absence reporting' or by calling school on 0151 558 1123 (Option 3)

Leave of Absence

The Government has issued national guidelines which all schools must follow. They say that any term time holiday over 5 days will be subject to a fine of £160, reduced on early payment to £80, per parent, per child.

If a second holiday were made in school time during the next 3 years, the full fine will be issued. A third holiday within 3 years may result in prosecution. Please do not take your child out of school for holidays! I am happy to discuss any of this with you if you want to come in or call school,
