Governing Body Terms of Reference

Roles and responsibilities of the Governing Body at Brookside Primary School

The full Governing Body of Brookside Primary School meets at least once a term and has the following responsibilities:

- Co-opting or appointing persons to the Governing Body
- Electing a Chair and Vice-Chair
- Considering the LEA's Curriculum Policy
- Ensuring the National Curriculum is implemented
- Deciding the policy on charging and remissions
- Agreeing the general principles for discipline
- Approving the Annual Report
- Taking actions, as required or permitted by law, on matters relating to admissions
- Deciding any changes in the time of school sessions
- Appointing the Headteacher and Deputy Head
- Deciding a Whole School Pay Policy.

The Governing Body delegates responsibility for examining details of specific issues to two working teams. At Brookside, the two working teams are: **Resources**Committee and Teaching Learning & Curriculum Committee
