






SPOT THE DIFFERENCE



TEACHERS' NOTES & ANSWERS



Our quiz and puzzle pack for primary schools has been designed as a simple, fun way to raise awareness of the event and encourage pupils to join in with the fun and make a difference.

In the run-up to Red Nose Day, you could use the quiz and puzzles:

- in circle time sessions
- at the start or end of the school day
- as a fundraiser, asking for donations or a small fee to take part.

There are four separate activities to choose from:

- Red Nose Day Quiz with three rounds focusing on laughter, noses and anagrams. Why not put on a big quiz event? See the box below for ideas.
- Spot the Difference can your pupils spot the six changes to the picture?
- Red Nose Day Word Search find the Red Noses and other related words!
- **Superpower Maze** follow the lines to match the child with the superpower.

If you want to use the activities to raise some cash, ask the pupils to make a donation or pay a small fee to take part. And don't forget to use the giro in your fundraising pack or a downloadable paying-in slip to pay in any money you raise.

Organising a fundraising quiz

Do you fancy yourself as a quizmaster? Why not use the Red Nose Day Quiz questions to put on a big fundraising quiz event?

1. Find a space or get online!

Make sure that you have enough room for everybody to sit in teams and take part. Organise plenty of pens and quiz sheets. Alternatively, why not organise an online Red Nose Day Quiz?

2. Spread the word

Let the pupils know about your quiz. Tell them when and where it is, what it's for, and how much it will cost to take part.

3. Decide on an entry fee

Remember, all the cash you raise will go to help change people's lives. You could either charge for participation or ask pupils for a donation.

4. Have a prize!

Everyone loves winning, so offer a prize to reward the top team. If there's a draw, you could think up your own decider questions.
