Dear Parents/Carers,

Annual reminders for new families:

Firstly, I'd like to welcome all of our new parents/carers to our school community. We are looking forward to getting to know you and working with you to support your child with their learning this academic year. I understand that it can be quite overwhelming to take in the vast amounts of information that is given to you when your child starts school, including getting to know the different apps/payment systems/communication methods that we use. If you are feeling worried about any of this or are unsure, please call into the school office and both myself and Mrs Bryden are happy to help in whichever way we can. Most of our families are very familiar with the way we work in school, but I feel it is worthwhile to inform new parents/carers of some of our requests whilst on the school site:

- Please avoid driving into the school car park to drop-off/collect children, particularly around the times of 8.30-9am and from 3-3.30pm unless you are a blue-badge holder. The car park becomes very busy at these times and we want to ensure the safety of all of our pupils.
- Smoking/vaping is not permitted on the school site (including the car park)
- Please can all pupils be encouraged to get off bikes/scooters at the school gate and push them through the school yard to the storage pods to avoid any accidents. Please talk to your child about the importance of wearing cycle helmets also.
- Please can dogs be tied up at the school gates or carried in arms as we do have some pupils who are nervous around dogs

Forest School site:

This year, we are going to try to develop our very own forest school site on our school field. To support us with this, any donations of the following items would be hugely appreciated:

- building bricks (just up to 30)
