Dear Parents/Carers

Strive for Five winners:

A huge well done to our **Year 2 pupils** who were the first winners of the Strive for Five reading competition of 2024! In last week's assembly, I talked to all children about the importance of regular reading at home. Our staff can see the impact that 5/10 minutes of daily reading can have on pupil's attainment – the impact that this has on pupil's learning is HUGE and is such a great habit to get in to. We are aware that some pupils can be reluctant to read at home, for a variety of reasons such as not choosing books which match their interests, choosing books which are too difficult or possibly because they just need a little more practice to read fluently and they find reading challenging. As a school, we have worked incredibly hard to offer a wide-range of high-quality fiction/non-fiction books for children of all reading abilities - if you feel that your child is reluctant to read at home, please let us know using the Dojo messenger service and staff will allocate time to talk to your child and support them to choose a book which interests them.

Out-of-School Club:

Our wonderful wrap-around-care provision, led by Amanda and Alex, continues to go from strength to strength and we have had lots of new starters recently who are really enjoying their time in OOSC. Our OOSC offers two morning sessions:

- Full morning session: 7.40-8.45am (£4.50 or £5 including breakfast)
- Half morning session: 8.15-8.45am (£2.50 or £3 including breakfast)

They also offer an after-school session from 3.20-4.30pm at a cost of £4.25 per session or £5 on a Friday afternoon for cookery. The club has daily themes for the after-school sessions, which are currently:

- Monday – Modelling (play-dough, plasticine etc)
- Tuesday – Construction (Lego and blocks etc)
- Wednesday – Cartoons/films
- Thursday – Homework/Technology (iPads)
- Friday - Cookery

Although we offer a daily theme, it is ultimately up to the children which activity they would like to do and so they do not have to take part in the activities offered. When the weather improves and becomes more settled, the OOSC like to utilise our outdoor space as much as possible and even enjoy venturing over to the village park in the summer months.
