You will be able to make bookings up to 4pm on Friday 1st March when the window to make appointments will close. Appointments will be based around your child's academic progress and will be strictly allocated ten-minute slots (including face-to-face appointments) which will ensure that it is fair for all parents.

KABS launched their sponsored Readathon challenge during this morning's assembly. They have set a small number of fun reading tasks for children to complete, and once completed they will be entered into a raffle draw to win book vouchers from the local bookshop in Cockermouth.
