Dear Parents/Carers

Strive for Five winners:

I set the reading challenge in last week's Celebration Assembly to see whether we could have any class reach 100%, meaning that every child in the class had read five times during the week in their own time.... I'm delighted to report that <u>Years 4 and 5</u> accepted that challenge and got to the magical <u>100%</u> last week! Amazing! Well done Blencathra!!! They were closely followed by Year 1 (91%) and Reception (93%). It is wonderful to see those Strive for Five reading %'s increasing this week – long may it last!

Parents evening appointments:

Some dates for your calendar... We plan to hold our spring term parents evening appointments on Monday 4th March (1.30-6pm) – virtual, and Monday 11th March (3.30-5.30pm) – face-to-face. As we still have over a month to go, the appointment booking system has not gone live just yet - I will let you all know as soon as they are available to book. The spring term meetings are an opportunity to discuss your child's academic achievements and progress since September with their class teacher.

Reporting absence:

If your child is unable to attend school through feeling unwell, there are two options for reporting this to school. You can either call the main school office on 01900 828971 and leave a message stating your child's name, class and the reason for absence, or you can use the school website by clicking on the 'Reporting Absence' tab at the top of the page and completing a webform. Please inform school of absence by 8.30am in order for us to inform your child's class teacher so that they are not incorrectly marked in the register as 'late'. If you would like to request term-time absence due to a holiday, the holiday request form can be downloaded from the school website, or a hard copy can be provided from the school office. In order for me to authorise absence due to holidays, it has to meet a threshold for 'exceptional circumstances' set by our local authority.

Packed lunches/school lunches:

Recently, we have found that we have had a number of requests for children to swap from packed lunches to school lunches, or vice versa. We are always happy to facilitate these requests, but we would like to politely ask for 4 weeks' notice of the change in an email to Mrs Bryden in our school office: <u>admin@broughton-pri.cumbria.sch.uk</u> As Mrs Farley cooks all school lunches on site, she has to pre-purchase all of her ingredients in advance and she bases this on the number of children that are currently having a school dinner, and if there are number of requests to swap, the concern is that she has not ordered enough food, or that food may be wasted. Many schools in the local area use external providers for school lunches and can put in a daily order, which would offer flexibility between school lunches and packed lunches on a day-to-day basis. We are very fortunate to provide freshly cooked lunches for our children, but this leaves us with less flexibility on making swaps and changes.
