#### **Strive for Five winners:**

Well done to last week's winners which was our Year 1 class, with 100% of the class reading five times during the week. Fantastic!

#### **Easter Fayre plans:**

The KABS Easter Fayre will take place tomorrow afternoon from 3-4pm. Due to this, our school day will finish at 3pm so please can all children be collected at this slightly earlier time. We are hoping to hold the Easter Fayre outside on our MUGA (weather permitting) – the entrance point for the Fayre will be the side gate (the usual entrance point for Nursery and Reception children). In the case of bad weather, we will bring it indoors and the entrance point will be the front red door (usual entrance point for children in Year 2-Year 6). The entrance fee is £1 per adult (children are free), which includes a hot drink and a biscuit. Children in Early Years and Key-Stage 1 will need to attend the Fayre with an adult, but pupils in Key-Stage 2 are able to attend by themselves if they wish. Children in Nursery and Reception are invited to make an Easter bonnet, and we have planned in an Easter parade to show case their amazing creations at the Fayre. Children in Year 1 – Year 6 can decorate an egg with any theme. The bonnets/eggs will be judged throughout the school day and all winners will be announced at the Fayre. All bonnets/eggs can be brought into school tomorrow morning and will be collected by your child's class teacher.

We are looking forward to seeing you there.

#### **Outstanding school lunch money:**

Unfortunately, we currently have nearly £900 in outstanding lunch money, which has a significant impact on the school finances. Please can school lunches be paid for a week in advance in order to reduce the outstanding total. We understand that some schools use a payment system which requires meals to be ordered and paid for in advance, which is a system that we have consciously avoided as it offers no flexibility in payments, however we may end up in a position where we have no other choice but to explore this option.

#### **Easter Service in Christ Church:**

I can confirm the Easter service will take place in Christ Church on Thursday at 9.30pm. We look forward to seeing you all there.
