Dear Parents/Carers

Strive for Five:

We did not report on last week's Strive for Five results and so will combine the results with this week's scores.

Attendance:

Our whole school attendance so far from the start of the academic year currently stands at: 94.6% with National attendance at: 95%, meaning we fall slightly below the national average. However, our school attendance seems to be on the increase and for last week alone stood at 97% with the national average for last week being 94.5%. I do understand that autumn term is usually the season for higher rates of illness and fully support your decision to keep your child off school if they are too poorly to attend, which I appreciate is beyond the control of your child, parents/carers and also school. It would be fantastic, however, if we could continue on the upward incline with school attendance as we move towards the Christmas break. I will be carrying out a termly attendance audit in December and will be sending home personal letters of congratulations for any child who has managed to achieve 100% attendance throughout autumn term. I will also send home letters offering support for any child with attendance below 90%, which the Department for Education classes as persistent absence. If you have any worries or concerns around your child's attendance in school, please let me know and I would be very happy to offer any support that I can.

Broughton Light Switch-on:

The fabulous 'Light Up Broughton 2024' event will take place this Sunday at 5pm. This year, KABS have organised a star trail and any properties in the village that have registered will be displaying a KABS star in their window – it is your job to count up how many KABS stars you can find. Anybody that registers a display on the map, or who completes the star trail and counts up the correct number of stars will be entered into a draw for a £25 Amazon voucher, courtesy of Adrian and Steph Davis-Johnston (please direct message Adrian with your star count). Our wonderful OOSC will be outside of school selling snacks and refreshments, and any money raised on this stall will go towards supporting the OOSC.

BPS Xmas Fayre:

The BPS Christmas Fayre will soon be upon us and will be held next Tuesday (5th December) from 3-4.30pm - where on earth has November gone?!? Please can all children be collected from school at the earlier time of 2.55pm – Key-Stage 2 pupils who usually walk home will be dismissed at this time so that they can attend the fayre. The entry point to the fayre will be the red OOSC door. We are aiming to keep costs low this year, and so the entry price per adult (children are free) will be £1.00, which includes a hot drink and biscuit. Stalls and games will reduce their costs too.

All children will bring home a small plastic bag this evening – please could we invite families to pop some sweet treats into the bag and return them to school for the fayre.
