Residential trips for Year 3/4 to Derwent Hill & Year 5/6 pupils to London will take place in the next academic year as they are bi-annual visits.

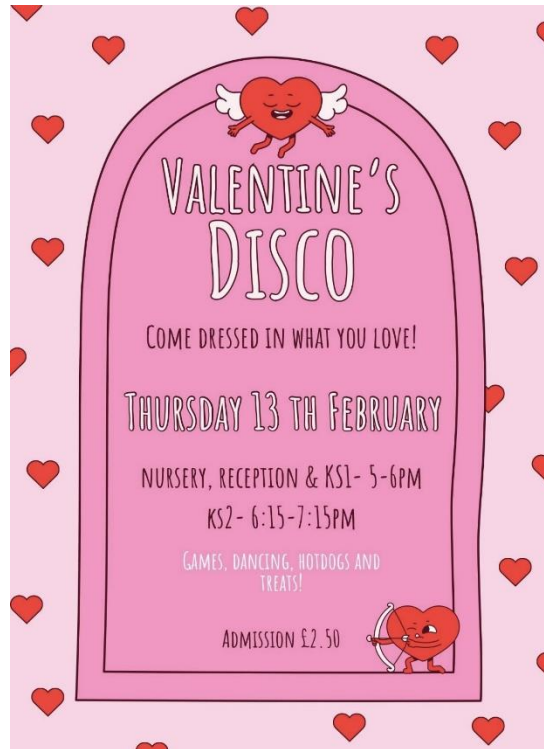
School lunch payments:
