All children should have brought home a sponsorship card with their individual class challenges on Friday afternoon, with the Readathon officially beginning today and running through to Friday afternoon. We are hoping that we can raise enough money to purchase a new reading library for a children's ward in a hospital that currently does not have one. World Book Day celebrations:

A quick reminder that it is World Book Day this Thursday and children are welcome to come to school dressed as a book character. We have lots of fun reading activities planned in too.



Early adopter of free breakfast club:

We are really excited to be one of only 25 schools in Cumbria to become an early-adopter of the free breakfast club funded by the Government. The free club will be launched on the first day of summer term (Tuesday 22nd April) and run to the last day of term (Tuesday 22nd July). As this is a brand-new government initiative, I have attended a series of webinars and online sessions led by the Department for Education to get further information about the logistics of running the free club. Some key points to share with you in advance of the club launching are as follows:

- The free breakfast club will run from **8.15-8.45am every morning in summer term**
- The club is funded for ALL children in RECEPTION to YEAR 6 unfortunately, children of Nursery age are not currently being funded by the government. However, we are still able to offer this session to Nursery children who wish to attend, but this will be at a cost of £1.25.
- There is no limit to how many children can attend each session and so no child would ever be turned away. Eventually, we will be able to offer this session without the need to pre-book, but in the initial stages we would like to request that parents pre-book the session online on SchoolMoney to give us an indication about how many children will be attending each session, so that we can pre-plan staffing, food shopping and space needed to run the club on a day-to-day basis. This will help Amanda and Alex immensely with their planning. Once up and running, we may be able to switch to children just showing up. There will be no payment to make when pre-booking for children in Reception to Year 6.
- OOSC will continue to offer wrap-around care from 7.35am to 8.15am but at a reduced price of £3.75 (including breakfast). You should continue to book and pay for these sessions online on SchoolMoney
- Although the food items available for the free breakfast club are still under consideration, they must be chosen from the 'School Foods Standards' handbook in order to meet the criteria for a funded breakfast club, but will like include items such as toast, porridge and a range of cereals.
- The survey to indicate your interest in your child attending the club, remains open until this Friday. Thank you for all of the responses submitted so far.

Parents Evening Appointments:

Face-to-face appointments for parents of pupils in **Year 1 to Year 6** will take place on Monday 17th March from 1.30-6pm and will be held in the school hall. You will be able to make bookings up to 4pm this Friday 7th March when the window to make appointments will close. Appointments will be based around your child's academic progress this year and will be strictly allocated ten-minute slots (including face-to-face appointments) which will ensure that it is fair for all parents.
